- The Initial page lists a few quick task modes to minimize setup time.

Audio Conference, Presentation, Lecture Capture and Video Conference

Note: Video Conference appears when pre-routed by AV support, but is accessible from the main menu. This is to ensure that shared units aren't routed unnecessarily.

Unsure what to pick? Touch the screen avoiding the icons to go to the main menu)



Main Menu



- Blu-ray: Provides DVD and High definition Blu-ray Disc playback.
- Document Camera: Projects a printed Document or transparency.
 Laptop: Activates the VGA, HDMI and audio cables for projection
- Decre DC: Disclare the week commutes on the presidents
 - Room PC: Displays the rack computer on the projector
- Lecture Capture: Enables positioning of the camera for recording.
 Aux Inputs: Enables either the HDMI input or Component Video input and the associated audio connection atop the podium.
- Video Conference: Two-way audio/video call to another VTC unit.
- Audio Conference: Conference in anyone with a telephone.

Combine up to 2 calls by using the Flash button.

Switching PC's

- Projector Display: Select the desired pc from the Room PC menu. By pressing either PC 1 of PC 2. The selected PC will highlight.
- Keyboard/Mouse/Monitor:
 Use the Switch Local
 control/View button to swap
 the keyboard/mouse and the
 confidence monitor between
 the 2 PC's

By selecting the Advancer Request check box, the tech will know to bring a slide advancer to the room.


Room Off Power down after use



The projectors cool down prior to shut off and will take a few minutes to restart if needed. Be sure your session at an end.


What To Where?
